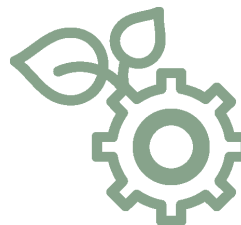

U.S. Army Joint Base Lewis-McChord Training Support Services (TSS) Enterprise Mission Support; Integrated Training Area Management (ITAM) Program

As part of our sustainability services capability, we provide the Range and Training Land Assessment (RTLTA), Land Rehabilitation and Maintenance (LRAM), and Sustainable Range Program (SRP) GIS components of the JBLM ITAM program that support the U.S. Army's integration of military mission, natural resource stewardship, and environmental compliance. Under this subcontract to Booz Allen Hamilton (BAH), our eight FTEs provide the maintenance of Army training lands to ensure quality training and realism, reduce environmental damage, and enhance the public image of the Army as a conscientious land steward.

Niagara Wastewater System Niagara Air Reserve Station (ARS) Support Services

As part of our O&M capability, we manage, control, and perform operations, maintenance, repairs, replacements, expansions, and incidentals. Our two FTEs ensure dependable, 24/7 utility services to each government or tenant connection within the service area. We perform the reading, maintenance, and calibration of all sub-meters on the privatized utility system, including additional meters that may be installed within the contract period. We are a subcontractor to Engineering and Environment, Inc.



U.S. Army Ft. Devens Department of Public Works (DPW) Geographic Information Systems (GIS), Computer- Aided Design and Drafting (CADD), and Facility Support

As part of our sustainability services capability, we support the DPW with the following services: research, investigate, and organize drawing records; create CADD drawings of buildings, infrastructure, and facilities; perform field verification of site conditions; and organize, file, and reproduce drawings and engineering records. Our three FTEs operate as on-site energy conservation coordinators by overseeing and coordinating building energy monitor (BEM) services. We provide facility management by visiting base facilities, buildings, pavements, grounds, and activities to evaluate the facility condition and verify record information.

Defense Information Systems Agency (DISA) Defense Enterprise Accounting and Management System

As part of our Technology Services capability, we provide services to our sister company, DDC ITS, as a subcontractor. We deliver system administration support for the DISA DEAMS mission partner by performing Solaris technical support for Solaris server systems. Our personnel also manage and maintain the most current version and two previous versions of the Solaris OS on physical and virtual operating environments. We install, configure, maintain, manage, and troubleshoot Solaris OS and associated components.
